## AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE ILPE PROJECT

5. Provide exposure to diverse leadership styles and strategies from various cultures.
6. Equip participants with the ability to navigate and succeed in a globalized professional environment.
7. Integrate real-world case studies and simulations to enhance practical leadership capabilities.
8. Develop the skill of action research & establish himself/herself as a researcher.

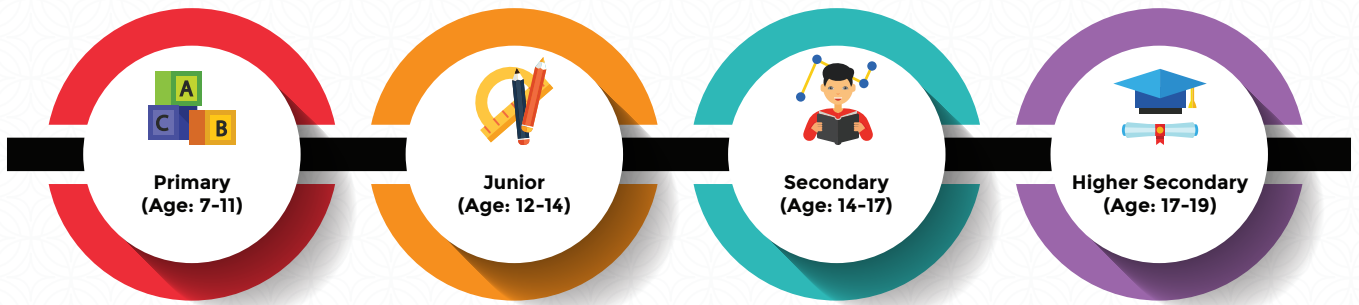
## OUTCOMES:

7. Undergo a transformative experience, gaining insights into their own strengths and areas for improvement, setting the stage for ongoing personal growth.

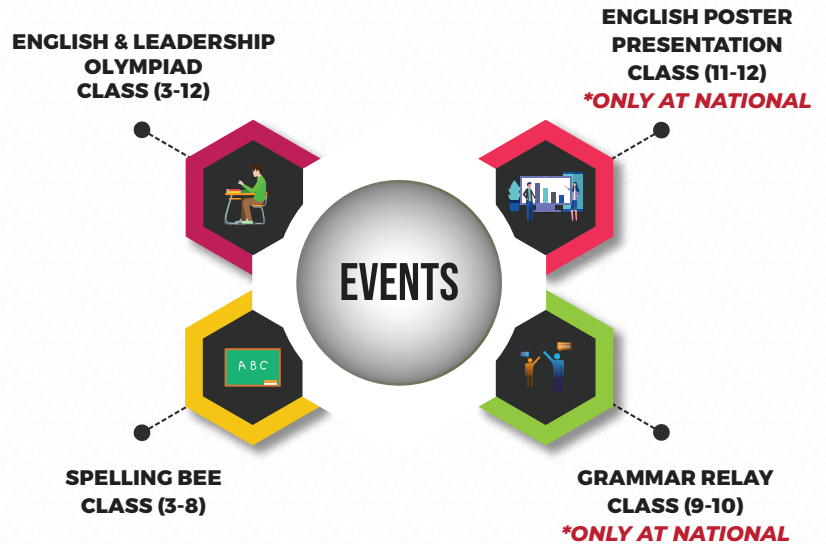

Our events are designed to strengthen core academic and cognitive skills at developmentally appropriate stages while enriching confidence and curiosity. By engaging students in structured problem solving, language application, and creative expression, the programs enhance critical thinking, communication, and analytical abilities that are essential for academic success. They also encourage healthy competition, teamwork, and time management, helping students develop resilience and adaptability.



## RULES AND REGULATION

### EVENT LIST

- **Olympiad: class 3-12**

### EVENT DETAILS :

- The events will be held physically on the day of the event.
- Participants must bring their own writing materials.
- No electronic devices or reference materials are allowed during the competition.

## 1. Olympiad

Are you ready to challenge your knowledge and sharpen your thinking? The Olympiad invites students to engage deeply with core academic concepts through structured, thought-provoking questions. Designed to encourage learning before competition, this year's Olympiad features a clearly outlined syllabus and previous years' questions, enabling participants to build understanding, strengthen fundamentals, and confidently apply their knowledge in a competitive setting.

**Topic:** English Grammar, Reading, Writing, Speaking, Leadership, Climate.

**Format:** MCQ and written. The exam will be on 50 marks, 60% language skills, 10% Bangladesh, 10% International affairs, 20% climate science.

**Duration:** 60 Minutes

**Categories:** Primary (Grade 3 to 5), Junior (Grade 6 to 8 ), Secondary (Grade 9 to 10), and Higher Secondary (Grade 11 to 12).

## 2. Spelling Bee

Do words excite you? The Spelling Bee is an exhilarating opportunity to explore the beauty, structure, and potency of language. Participants will branch out their vocabulary and boost linguistic confidence through vast preparation. Students are encouraged to master spelling through understanding rather than memorization.

**Format:** Written. Words with incorrect spelling will be provided in the sheet. Students will be required to find it out and correct it.

**Duration:** 60 Minutes



### 3. Grammar Relay Race

Think fast, think clearly, and think correctly. The Grammar Relay Race transforms grammar learning into an engaging, collaborative challenge. Participants apply grammatical rules in real time, enhancing accuracy, speed, and teamwork. This event emphasizes practical language use, reinforcing clarity and correctness through active problem-solving rather than passive learning.

**Format:** Written and verbal.

**Duration:** 60 Minutes

**Categories:** Secondary (Grade 9 to 10), only at nationals.

#### Rules & Regulations:

- Each team must consist of 4 members. All team members must participate in at least one part of the relay.
- The race will have multiple “stations,” each featuring a different grammar task (e.g. sentence correction, punctuation, identifying parts of speech). Tasks must be completed in the correct sequence to advance.
- Time will begin when the first team member starts the first task.
- Answers must be written or marked as instructed at each station.
- Once a team moves to the next station, their previous task is locked and cannot be changed.
- Only one team member may work on the task at each station.
- Once a task is completed, the next team member may proceed to the next station.
- No electronic devices, reference books, or notes are allowed.
- If a team skips a station or receives unauthorized assistance, they will be disqualified.
- The team with the fastest adjusted time (accounting for penalties) and the highest accuracy will be declared the winner. In the event of a tie, a bonus round with one additional grammar challenge will determine the winner.

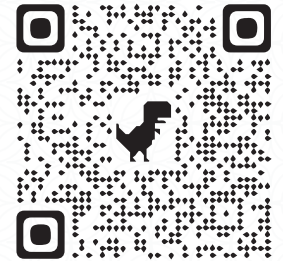
## 4. Poster Presentation

Ready to express ideas visually and creatively? The Poster Presentation provides a platform for students to research, organize, and communicate their thoughts on meaningful topics. Participants learn to combine content, design, and presentation skills to convey powerful messages effectively. This event nurtures creativity, critical thinking, and confident public expression.

**Open To:** Higher Secondary (Grade 11–12)

**Poster Size:** A0 (Printed on PVC or Sticker Paper)

**Poster Structure** (Mandatory Sections)



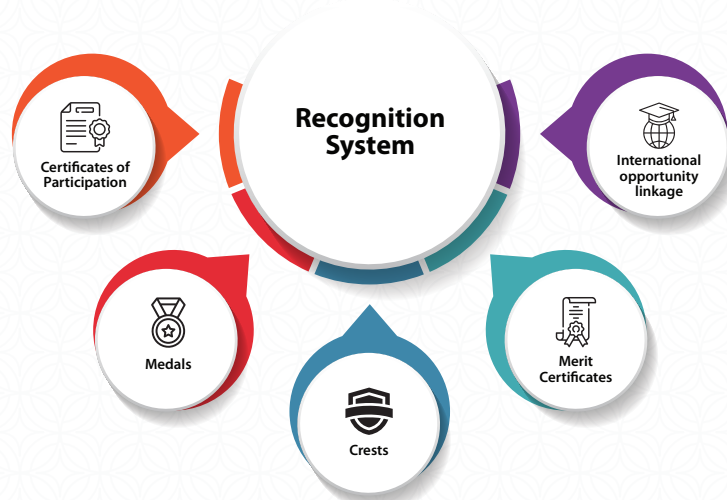

### Rules and Regulations

1. This is a team-based event. Each team must consist of up to 3 members.
2. Posters that do not follow the A0 size, PVC or Sticker Paper format, or required structure will be disqualified.
3. All content must be original. Any form of plagiarism will result in immediate disqualification.
4. The poster must be clear, well-organized, and visually appealing.
5. The name(s) and institution(s) of the participants must be placed at the top of the poster.
6. Judges' decisions will be final and binding.

- Depth of understanding and clarity of content
- Delivery & Engagement
- Visual presentation and readability
- Relevance and coherence of ideas
